THE LAWS OF THE KINGS

In Deuteronomy 17:14-20 Yahweh set the "Laws of the King" which limited the monarchy and prohibited certain excesses:

- ♦ Must be an Israelite
- ♦ He must not acquire many horses
- ♦ He must not send to Egypt to increase the power of his army
- ♦ He must not have many wives
- ♦ He must not acquire vast quantities of wealth.
- He must keep a copy of these laws with him and must read them every day.
- He must be a servant to his people and not think of himself as superior to the people.
