David is anointed three times:

First he was as a boy privately anointed by Samuel (1 Sam 16:13).
Next he was made king over the tribe of Judah (2 Sam 2:4).

Finally he was crowned king over a united Israel (2 Sam 5:3).
David's dynasty ruled over Israel and then Judah for 425 years until the Babylonian conquest.
