Questions for group discussion:

There is always warfare between the material and the spiritual—between what the world interprets as pleasurable and what God tells us is sinful or righteous behavior. Nothing material is inherently evil. It is the application of the material that can be used for evil and not for good. The amount of money we have isn't as important as our attitude toward it and the way we use it (see 1 Timothy 6:10; Luke 12:48; and Matthew 6:24).

Question: What is your attitude toward money and material possessions? Are there responsibilities associated with money and material blessings?

Question: Why does Christ give Himself to us, Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity in the Most Holy Eucharist? How was this precious gift prefigured in the Old Testament?

Question: How does our sharing in the life of the Most Holy Trinity begin, and how does that relationship deepen throughout our faith journey?

Question: Is the Eucharist necessary for our salvation? See John 6:41-58 (verse 57 is the key) and CCC # 1324-1327, 1341-1344, 1389-1396, and 2180.
